



## IGNITION


To start, use the **Arrow Buttons** to move the orange selection square to the white **Start/Stop Icon** and press the **Select Button**. Confirm the selection by holding the **Select Button** down for 3 seconds (safety feature). White icon turns orange.



*Starting* will appear on the screen. The light orange combustion light will light up when the burner flame has been ignited and the combustion has stabilized (in about 5 min). Stove will be fully operational about 10 min later.

## POWER LEVEL SETTING

Use the **Arrow Buttons** (left or right) to move the orange selection square to the **Main Menu Bar**. Press **Select Button** to activate the **Main Menu Bar**. Use **Arrow Buttons** to choose the **Manual Mode** and press the **Select Button** to select.




Use the **Arrow Buttons** to move the orange selection square to the **Power Level** and press **Select Button** (picture 2).

Press **Arrow Buttons** to set the desired power level (1-6).

## SHUT DOWN

Quick shut down:  
Press and hold the **Select Button** down for more than 4 seconds.

*Stopping* will appear and the Power Icon light will change to white indicating the unit is off.




Alternatively use the **Arrow Buttons** to move the selection square to the **Start/Stop Icon** and press the **Select Button**.



Press and hold the **Select Button** down for more than 2 seconds.




*Stopping* will appear and the Power Icon light will change to white indicating the unit is off.



## SETTINGS

Get familiar with the control panel's functionality. Read more from User Manual.

Move the selection square to the **Main Menu Bar** and press the **Select Button**. Use the **Arrow Buttons** to choose **Settings**. Press the **Select Button**.




Use the **Arrow Buttons** to move the selection square down and press the **Select Button** to choose.




The stove operation can be optimized to different altitudes.

Select the altitude from settings before starting the unit.





## LOCK

(SAFETY FEATURE)


If a **Lock Icon** is displayed, the device has locked itself for safety. The unit will also lock after 2 unsuccessful starts (first startup). Move the selection square to the **Exclamation Point Icon** and press the **Select Button**. An Error Page will appear.



If the device has locked itself, there may have been a failure that should be investigated and resolved prior to further use. The error page will display a check list and a website for further information. If you need help, reach out to a professional.



To remove the lock, press any button to return to the main display. Move the selection square to the **Main Menu Bar** and press the **Select Button**, choose **Settings**, and press the **Select Button**. Choose **Clear Lock** from the Settings Menu and press the **Select Button**.



## COOKING PLATE

Clean stove top regularly. Do not use abrasive cleaning sponges or agents.

Select high-quality pots, casseroles and pans and follow the markings in the cooking pots.
